



## **Call for applicants: Women Rise in Politics (WRiP) Mentorship and Training Programme**

Zimbabwe Gender Commission is established in terms of Section 245 of the Constitution of Zimbabwe to promote, protect, enforce, and advance gender equality. One of the functions Commission is to recommend affirmative action programs designed to achieve gender equality as provided for in the Constitution.

Pursuant to its mandate, the Commission has partnered with UN Women to develop the initiative Women Rise in Politics (WRiP), a mentorship and training program to build capacity and confidence of aspiring women political candidates. Young women, rural-based women, women with disabilities, women living with HIV among others, are especially encouraged to apply. The programme aims to cover all 10 provinces of Zimbabwe.
